More than just one day, Introduce a Girl to Engineering is a movement to show girls and students of marginalized gender the fascinating world of engineering—and how engineers are changing our world.

Use the tips below and our extensive library of resources to plan your Girl Day event!

Inspire a Girl's Future! Be a Role Model

- Visit with a girl-serving organization. In as little as 45 minutes you can tell the girls about your job, how your work makes a difference, lead a hands-on engineering activity, and answer their questions.
- Encourage girls to explore careers. Present engineering as a career. Share your own experiences and talk about engineering in a way that's appealing and aligns with girls' interests.
- <u>Share Chats with Change Makers</u>. Introduce girls to video series featuring interviews with role models in a diverse range of engineering careers.
- Volunteer as a Future City mentor or judge. With a 50-50 ratio of girls and boys, Future City challenges middle and high school students to design a city that can exist 100 years in the future. Volunteer for just one day as a judge or work with a team.
- Organize a girl-focused engineering event. Our survey results found girls like the activities best. Followed by the food, working in teams with other girls, and talking to role models about their jobs. Check out <u>sample events</u> and see what others have done.
